



REGULAR ADMISSION

Students / Guardians are expected to read the prospectus carefully and submit the admission form duly filled on or before the due date. Last date of submission of admission form will be declared later on.

- 01. Admission will be strictly on merit.
- 02. Application for admission must be accompanied by the following documents and certificates:
 - a) The school or college leaving certificate in original.
 - b) Marksheet of last examination passed or failed together with original and two attested true copies of it.
 - c) Character certificate.
 - d) Migration certificate, in case of students who are the students of a university other than RTM Nagpur University or Education Board other than the Maharashtra State Board of Secondary Education with the immigration fee of Rs. 200/-. A late fee of Rs. 200/- will be charged if the migration certificate is not submitted by the students on the prescribed date.
 - e) No objection certificate, in case of the students who are employed.
 - f) Two passport size photographs of the student.
- 03. Personal interview is necessary for the admission. The student must bring the original documents with them at the time of interview.
- 04. Parents should also remain present at the time of finalizing the admission.
- 05. Selected candidates for admission should pay the admission fees within the declared date, failing which the claim for admission will be cancelled.
- 06. Students seeking EBC / PTC / Scholarship / other concessions should submit the relevant forms to the office separately on or before the date declared by the Principal after the admission.
- 07. EBC / PTC / Scholarship / other concession forms should not be attached with the admission form in any case otherwise their scholarship / concession forms will not be considered by the office and such students will be treated as full fee payee.



- 08. Selected candidates for admission must submit the original documents along with the prescribed fees.
- 09. Even in the case of fresh admission, if in the opinion of the Principal, the admission to any person of any class who have been on previous occasion, found to be unruly and whose conduct or attitudes towards college authorities has been found to be injurious to the maintenance of peace and tranquility in the campus, the Principal for such reasons, may refuse to give admission to such a person & such decision of the Principal will be final and irrevocable by any other authority.
- 10. If student cancelled their admission before last date of admission then he/she will charged Rs. 1000/- as processing fees. If cancelled after admission date he/she will be charged full tuition fees and other fees.

The application form bearing following features will be strictly rejected.

- 01. Application not submitted in the prescribed format or incomplete application.
- 02. Application without necessary documents or certificates.
- 03. Application with false information etc.

The provisional admission of the students subjected to the result of re-assessment.

Candidate should pay 10% of actual fees payable for admission (which is non refundable). If the candidate does not succeed in reassessment, the provisional admission will get automatically cancelled.

The candidate will be required to submit a declaration and undertaking in the prescribed format on the stamp paper of Rs. 100/- duly authenticated by the Principal.

REMOVAL FROM THE COLLEGE

The Principal reserves the right to remove the name of any student from the rolls for :-

- 01. Failure to pay college dues before the due date.
- 02. Failure to come up to academic standard.
- 03. Conduct, which in the opinion of the Principal, is unsatisfactory and objectionable.

SCHOLARSHIP

The Govt. of India Scholarship to the S.C./S.T./O.B.C./V.J. / N.T. /S.B.C./Rajarshi Shahu Maharaj Shikshan Shulk Shishyavruti Scheme for Open Category students is granted on the basis of income. All such students have essential to open Bank account in any Nationalised Bank.

Scholarship will not be granted in the following cases:-

- 01. If the income of the parent / guardian from all sources exceeds Rs. 2,50,000/- in previous year for S.C., S.T. & Rs. 1,50,000/- for OBC, SBC, VJ/NT.
- 02. Failure to open Bank account in any Nationalised Bank & link Aadhar No. to Bank account.
- 03. Students who completed professional course.
- 04. Students having less than 75% attendance.

PROCEDURE FOR SUBMISSION OF FORM

FOR GOI SCHOLARSHIP:-

All the students coming under the lower income group should apply for above Govt. of India escholarship and Maharashtra State Govt. Scholarship in the prescribed form through online & submit hard copy in the college within a month after their admission.

The students should be vigilant enough to fill in the form complete in all respects as any omission or incorrect / false information may disqualify them for the above scholarship.

FREE-STUDENTSHIP EDUCATION CONCESSION:-

- 01. Free studentship to children of Primary / Secondary School Teachers.
- 02. Free studentship to D. C. Students.

FOR RAJARSHI SHAHU MAHARAJ SHIKSHAN SHULK SHISHYAVRUTI SCHEME:-

A) For non-professional course, if Income is upto Rs. 8,00,000/- applicant will get benefit of tuition fees & exam fees (For Govt. Course - 100%, for non-govt aided course-100%, for partially aided courses-100%, for permanent unaided course-100%)



ELIGIBILITY:-

- Income certificate must be of less than 8 lakh.
- 2. As per govt, resolution first two children are eligible for scheme.
- 3. Applicant should be domicile of Maharashtra.
- 4. Applicant should not avail any other scholarship or stipend.
- 5. During course duration, candidate should not have a gap of 2 years.

DOCUMENTS REQUIRED:-

- 1. Students should have Annual Income Certificate issued from Tahsildar.
- 2. Family declaration certificate about two children.

- 3. Applicant's Domicile Certificate.
- 4. Attendance certificate with 50% from concerned college.
- 5. Receipt of Exam fees.

6. Previous year marksheet

PRIMARY / SECONDARY SCHOOL TEACHER'S WARD CONCESSION:-

Children of all full time Primary / Secondary School Teachers working in Government, local bodies school and recognized and aided private Primary / Secondary school etc. are eligible for concession of free studentship.

Condition of eligibility:

- Free studentship will be subjected to regular attendance (not less than 75%), satisfactory progress and good conduct.
- Free studentship will be awarded only to those pupils whose parents are residents of Maharashtra State.
- Application should be made within a period of 30 days from date of the opening of the college.

MEDICAL INSPECTION (Ordinance No. 84)

Every student of the college should present himself / herself for Medical Inspection before the Medical Officer of the college on such date or dates as may be fixed by the Medical officer in consultation with the Principal.

- a) A student who remains absent in Medical Examination on the appointed date and time without sufficient cause, will be liable to pay to the college a fine of Rs. 50/- or such sum as the college may fix before he is examined.
- b) A student who fails to present himself for medical inspection without sufficient cause even after repeated opportunity given, should have to pay a fine of Rs. 25/- in addition to the prescribed fees.



ATTENDANCE

- a) In order to appear at the university examination every student must attend not less than 75% of the lectures delivered.
- b) Leave of absence will be given at his / her own risk and even a medical certificate or application of absence from the guardian will not entitle him / her for condonation of deficiency in the percentage of attendance in lectures required by university.
- c) A fine of Re. 1/- will be imposed to the student absent for each subject period. Students who desire to take leave must send in writing the application duly counter signed by their parents or guardian to the principal well in time.

COLLEGE EXAMINATION

Annual test examination for semester pattern will be taken in the third week of September for first, third & fifth semester and in the first week of February for second, fourth & sixth semester. Students who failed to attend the semester test exam will have to pay 25/- per subject and the students scoring less than 15% marks will have to pay a fine of Rs. 05/- per subject.

PHYSICAL EDUCATION (Ordinance No. 9)

- A) Physical Education is compulsory for all the students of the college in all the faculties.
 - 1) There will be three periods per week for physical education.
 - 2) Each period will be of 30 minutes. This period will include physical exercise, games and recreation activities.
- B) Following games are played in our institution and participated in Intercollegiate Tournament.
 - i) Outdoor Games: 1) Cricket 2) Volleyball 3) Basketball 4) Football 5) Badminton
 - 6) Kabaddi 7) Kho-kho 8) Tug of war 9) Athletic
 - ii) Indoor Games: 1) Table tennis 2) Chess 3) Carom
- C) A student must attend at least 80% of the Physical Education periods in a session.
- D) The following students will be exempted from the operation of the ordinance.
 - i) Students having been completed the age of 26 years at the time of admission.



- ii) Student found unfit on medical ground, if recommended by the medical officer of the college to the principal with detailed reason of unfitness.
- iii) The final year students:-

Student who have participated in:-

- a) Inter collegiate or b) Inter universities or c) State tournaments
- iv) Students attending Social Service Camp organized by the College NSS Unit.
- v) Such student who attend college gymnasium and out door sports.
- E) A student who is eligible for exemption under clause "C" on the ground of medical unfitness shall obtain exemption in the prescribed form from the principal before 10th of January every year. He shall annex exemption certificate to his application for admission to the examination.
- F) Student of the college have to undergo physical efficiency test once a year. If a student fails to present herself/himself at the Physical Efficiency Test without sufficient causes, he /she has to pay a fine of Rs. 25/- in addition to the prescribed fees.

NATIONAL SERVICE SCHEME

The college organizes Social Service Camp for 7 days under N.S.S. in the nearby village for activities like Adult Education, Cleaning of Wells, Improvement of Roads, Imparting First Aid knowledge to villagers, Village upliftment activities and "Shramdan" activities etc. Regular activities are performed in whole year in the college.

STUDENT AID FUND
